IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

DANGER

- (5) Do not overreach. Keep proper footing and balance at all times. Proper footing and balance enables better control of the Nailer in unexpected situations.
- (6) Use safety equipment. A dust mask, non-skid safety shoes and a hard hat must be used for the applicable conditions.
- (7) **WARNING** - Risk of hearing loss. Wear hearing protection. Hearing protection shall have a Noise Reduction Rating (NRR) determined in accordance with US Environmental Protection Agency rules that is appropriate for noise exposure.
- (8) **Always wear head protection.** Head protection shall conform to ANSI Z89.1, "American National Standard for Industrial Head Protection" as published by the American National Standards Institute.
- (9) Do not attach the hose to the Nailer to your body. Attach the hose to the structure to reduce the risk of loss of balance if the hose shifts.
- (10) **WARNING** - Drive nails into proper work surface only. Do not drive nail into other materials. Driving the fastener to be deflected and hit someone, or cause the Nailer to stop and result in a risk of injury to persons.

- 3. Nailer use and care
 - (1) Use claims or other practical way to secure and support the workpiece to a stable platform.
 - (2) Do not force the Nailer. Use the correct Nailer for the application. The correct Nailer will be the Nailer and safer at the rate for which the Nailer is designed.
 - (3) **Never use Nailer which is defective or operating abnormally.** If the Nailer appears to be doing unusually, making strange noises, or otherwise appears defective, stop using it immediately and report to the Nailer manufacturer.
 - (4) Connect a hose before nail loading and check the following. Check for air leakage and abnormal noise.
 - (5) Use of the Nailer in an abnormal condition may cause accidents or injuries. If an abnormality is detected, ask your dealer or HITACHI authorized service center for repair.
 - (6) Disconnect the Nailer from the air source before making any adjustments, changing accessories, or storing the Nailer.
 - (7) Such preventive safety measures reduce the risk of starting the Nailer unintentionally.
 - (8) Store the Nailer in a safe place out of reach of children and other untrained persons. A Nailer is dangerous in the hands of untrained users.
 - (9) Maintain the Nailer in good condition. Keep the Nailer Clean and lubricated for better and safer performance.
 - (10) Check for misalignment or binding of moving parts, breakage of parts, and any other condition that may affect the Nailer's operation.
 - (11) If damaged, have the Nailer serviced before using. Because of high air pressure in the Nailer, cracks on the surface are dangerous. To avoid this, do not drop the Nailer or strike the Nailer against hard surfaces, and do not scratch or engrave signs on the Nailer. Many accidents are caused by poorly maintained Nailer. There is a risk of starting if the Nailer is damaged.
 - (12) Do not use the Nailer that is not in proper working order. Tags and accessories are placed together for use as control.
 - (13) Shoot the nail just before it is out of reach of children and other untrained persons. A Nailer is dangerous in the hands of untrained users.
 - (14) **Never use reactive gases or other bottled gases, explosion may occur.** Never use reactive gases such as oxygen, combustible gases or any other bottled gases as a power source for the Nailer.
 - (15) Avoid long time nailing operation. Make sure to finish nailing in a short time as possible. Also, avoid continuous operation and allow adequate cooling time between operations.
